What is PGx testing?

Did you know that your DNA can play a role in how you may respond to certain medications? For example, your body may break down a medication too slowly or too quickly, which could result in side effects, or no therapeutic effect at all. A pharmacogenomic (PGx) test provides valuable information your doctor can use to determine how your DNA may affect which medications work well for you.

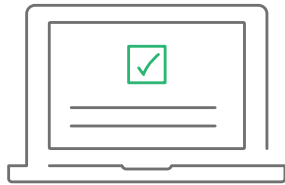
Who can benefit from the RightMed Test

- NEW PRESCRIPTION NEEDS

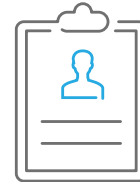
Your doctors can use your genetic test results over the course of your lifetime to help them make more informed medication decisions for you for many different medical conditions.
