



The RightMed Comprehensive Test is a prescription pharmacogenomic (PGx) test that analyzes an individual's DNA to help providers determine how he or she may respond to certain medications.

The following table lists medications that will be classified in the RightMed Comprehensive Test Report according to an individual patient's genotype and the medication interaction determined by the RightMed Test. Classification consists of major, moderate, and minimal gene-drug interactions.

This table does not include Limited PGx Impact medications, which appear in the RightMed Comprehensive Test Report. Limited PGx Impact medications have been shown to have no pharmacogenetic variants significantly impacting medication response variability.
